Acceptance Criteria

Our goal is to accept as many vehicles as possible; however these are guidelines only. Volunteers of America Oregon reserve the right to turn down a vehicle donation. We attend vehicle auctions weekly to observe current market conditions.

- Donor's who deliver "running vehicles" to specific location upon request will be sent a \$30 gift certificate to any McMenamin's Restaurant.
- The vehicle must have an intact engine, transmission and all 4 wheels with inflated tires present and able to spin.
- We will not accept vehicles that have been in a fire, flood, or major collision. Or vehicles with broken axles, cracked blocks, thrown rods, blown head or headgasket, broken timing belt, broken cam shaft, or other broken engine part or transmission preventing it to run and drive if 10 years or older. Specialty vehicles such as classics, SUV's, 4-wheel drives and some pick-ups are almost always accepted even with the above problems.
- Vehicles on a "Possessory Lien" will not be accepted. The donor must have a clear title to the vehicle even if the title is not in their name. If the title has been lost or destroyed we can still accept donation; however, vehicle pick up will be delayed until "clear title" status can be determined and all documents (that we will provide) have been signed and returned to us.
- We accept "out of state titles". If the donor has lost or destroyed their out of state title we cannot accept donation until the donor obtains a new title. *Washington State being the exception.*

Our tow area is along the I-5 corridor from Cottage Grove to Longview and 50 miles on either side. Exceptions can made to tow from beyond our tow area; please call our office for details.
